Infant (n)	An <b>infant</b> is not <b>capable of</b> speaking, so it just screams until it gets what it wants.	<b>Infant</b> = baby .. رضيع <b>capable of</b> = able to .. قادر على..
consume (v)	He <b>consumes huge amount of</b> bread with every meal.	<b>consume</b> = to eat or drink.. يأكل /يلتهم <b>huge amount of</b> = extremely large in amount .. كمية هائلة ..
clarify (v)	Could you <b>clarify</b> the first point please? I don't understand it completely.	<b>clarify</b> = to explain.... يوضح / يشرح
alternative (adj)	I have no <b>alternative</b> but to ask you to leave.	<b>alternative</b> = a choice... خيار آخر ، بديل
ambiguous (adj)	The movie's ending is <b>ambiguous</b> .	<b>ambiguous</b> = vague, unclear .. غامض ، مبهم
Comprise (v)	The class is <b>comprised</b> mainly of Italian and French students.	<b>comprise</b> = consist of .. يتألف ، يتكوّن ، يشكّل
Consent (v,n)	The director <b>consented</b> to change the ending of the movie.	<b>consent</b> = to give permission .. موافقة ، يوافق
facilitate (v)	The new ramp will <b>facilitate</b> the entry of wheelchairs.	<b>facilitate</b> = to make something easier or possible .. يسهّل ، ييسّر ramp= ممر منحدر مخصص للعجلات
Indicate (v)	Her reply <b>indicated</b> a very full understanding of the current situation.	<b>Indicate</b> = to show/point/or make clear in another way.. يدل على ، يشير إلى
Regulate (v)	Parents should <b>regulate</b> how much TV their children can watch.	<b>Regulate</b> = to control something .. ينظّم ، يضبط
Prodigious (adj)	He seemed to have a <b>prodigious</b> amount of energy.	<b>Prodigious</b> = extremely great ... هائل ، مذهل
Integrate (v)	The idea with young children is to <b>integrate</b> learning with play.	<b>Integrate</b> = to combine \ to mix .. دمج ، خلط

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implore (v)	There are ten marks <b>allocated</b> to every question.	<b>implore</b> = to ask someone for something or to do something.. يتوسل (إلى) ، يستعطف
allocate (v)	He <b>consumes huge amount of</b> bread with every meal.	<b>allocate</b> = to give something as a share of a total amount .. يوزع ، (حصّة)
Fiasco (n)	The show was a <b>fiasco</b> - one actor forgot his lines, and another fell off the stage.	<b>Fiasco</b> = a complete failure .. فشل تام/ذريع
enable (v)	I'm looking for a job which will <b>enable</b> me to develop my skills.	<b>enable</b> = to make someone able to do something.. يُمكن
emblem (n)	The dove is the <b>emblem</b> of peace.	<b>emblem</b> = a symbol that represents something.. شعار، رمز
endeavour (v,n)	Engineers are <b>endeavouring</b> to locate the source of the problem.	<b>endeavour</b> = to try to do something.. يحاول جاهداً
compulsory (adj)	Education is <b>compulsory</b> for children between the ages of 5 and 16.	<b>compulsory</b> = obligatory = mandatory .. إلزامي
Onus (n)	As your mother, it is my <b>onus</b> to prepare you for a successful future	<b>Onus</b> = the responsibility or duty to do something.. مسؤولية / واجب
strenuous (adj)	His doctor advised him not to do any <b>strenuous</b> exercise.	<b>strenuous</b> = needing or using a lot of effort or energy.. شاق/ مُرهق
Abrupt (adj)	I was surprised by the <b>abrupt</b> change of the subject.	<b>aprupt</b> = sudden & unexpected مفاجئ / غير متوقع
Descend (v)	The aircraft began to <b>descend</b> .	<b>descend</b> = drop = move or fall backward يميل / يسقط
Desolation (n)	A scene of <b>desolation</b> .	<b>desolation</b> = a state of complete emptiness or destruction = bleakness خراب / كآبة / أسي
Amend (v)	In line 20, 'men' should be <b>amended</b> to 'people'.	<b>amend</b> = to change something = modify يعدل / يغيّر
Persist (v)	If the pain <b>persists</b> , consult a doctor.	<b>persist</b> = continue to exist. يستمر / يُلح / يُصر
Restrain (v)	When he started fighting, it took 4 police officers to <b>restrain</b> him.	<b>restrain</b> = to control something by force يسيطر / يقيد

Evasion (n)	Tax <b>evasion</b> .	<b>evasion</b> = the act of avoiding something or someone.. تهرب/ تقادي
Perennial (adj)	We face the <b>perennial</b> problem of not having enough money.	<b>perennial</b> = lasting very long time دائم / متكرر / معمر
Digress (v)	He <b>digressed</b> from the subject to deal with a related theory	<b>digress</b> = to move away from the main subject. استطرده/ انحرف
Prosperity (n)	The war was followed by a long period of peace and <b>prosperity</b> .	<b>prosperity</b> = the state of being successful ازدهار / رخاء
Sparingly (adv)	Long dash – should be used <b>sparingly</b> in formal writing.	<b>sparingly</b> = limited = in a restricted way بحذر / باعتدال
Deceased (adj)	The <b>deceased</b> shot her mother before killing herself.	<b>deceased</b> = dead الراحل/ المتوفي
Commence (v)	Shall we let the meeting <b>commence</b> ?	<b>commence</b> = to begin = to start something يبدأ / يشرع
Discriminate (v)	Police dogs can <b>discriminate</b> between the different smells.	<b>discriminate</b> = to be able to see the difference يفرق / يميز
Excerpt (n)	Norman Mailer is here to read an <b>excerpt</b> from his latest book.	<b>excerpt</b> = a short part taken from a speech, book, etc مقطع / مقتطف / جزء
Distort (v)	She accused her opponent of <b>distorting</b> the truth.	<b>distort</b> = to change something so that it is false or wrong يحرف / يزيّف
Erode (v)	His behaviour has <b>eroded</b> my confidence in him.	<b>erode</b> = to slowly reduce or destroy something يُضعف / يُزيل
Denote (v)	The colour red is used to <b>denote</b> danger.	<b>denote</b> = to represent something.. يدل على/ يشير لـ
